**Mrs. Huggins called the meeting to order.**

**Mr. Augustine gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.**

**Mr. Rod Dooley, from Dooley and Associates, presented the audit for the 2022 Fiscal Year. He stated that it was a clean audit. Mr. David Reuis made a motion to approve the audit as presented. Ms. Hughes seconded. The motion carried.**

**Mr. Reuis made a motion to approve the 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading of New Policy BBBB-Board Member Removal From Office. Mrs. Smith made a second. The motion carried.**

**Mrs. Smith made a motion to approve the 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading of New Policy IMDA-Patriotic Exercises. Mr. Reuis made a second. The motion carried.**

**Mr. Reuis made a motion to approve the 2<sup>nd</sup> and Final Reading of Updated Policy IMDB-Flag/Motto Displays. Ms. Hughes made a second. The motion carried.**

**Mrs. Smith made a motion to approve the financial report as information only. Mr. Reuis seconded the motion. The motion carried.**



The Director stated that on October 18<sup>th</sup> FFA took students to the State Fair in Columbia, SC. He stated it was FFA Day and students from around the state were invited. Students were able to see the agriculture exhibits, see students from around the state showing animals and participate in the state tractor driving competition. Wyatt Twitty, a Barnwell County Career Center student, won the individual state tractor driving contest.

The Director stated that on October 27<sup>th</sup> BCCC had their advisor/advisee meeting for the students. He stated that students were given scenarios written by Mrs. Walker to read aloud and discuss as a group on how they would handle the situations that were read.

The Director stated that on November 16<sup>th</sup> the students dressed for the career they desired to be in one day. He stated that Mrs. Walker had a red carpet set up and rolled out for the students.


The Director stated that on November 17<sup>th</sup> he attended the Barnwell County Meeting Street Scholarship Launch event at the Barnwell County Library. He stated that the Meeting Street Scholarship gives students who meet their criteria \$10,000 per year for 4 years of college. Students must be a graduate from a public high school, be eligible for the Life Scholarship, fill out their FAFSA and be eligible for the federal Pell grant. They also have to enroll in one of the participating universities.


The Director stated that BCCC observed Thanksgiving Holidays from November 25<sup>rd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup>.
