Mr. Augustine gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Director advised the Board that the media had been given notice of the meeting in compliance with the freedom of information act and a notice had been posted at the Center.

The Director stated that on October 18th he met with other principals to discuss how the schools could help each other. He stated that he discussed new certifications that will be offered as well as the new ag class. Ways to get information to the students was also discussed.


The Director stated that eleven of the fourteen students that received apprenticeships with Swiss Krono are either current or former students of the Career Center. He stated that the other three were from Allendale. He stated that it speaks highly of the training that the students receive from the teachers here at the Career Center.


The Director stated that on November 4th the Career Center hosted a CLNA meeting for the Lower Savannah Region. The CLNA (comprehensive local needs assessment) is required for Perkins funds each year. He stated that the team creates and writes a document sharing regional information.

The Director stated that Mrs. Sandifer took her students on two field trips. One to Walther Farms where they were shown how potatoes are grown and processed. The other was to two hunting plantations where they were shown land development and learned about trees. The Director also stated that there are new guidelines to drive the minibus. He stated that the driver has to go through a course and have a CDL. He stated that he has let the teachers know that if they wish to take the students on field trips they will have to comply with the new guidelines.
