

TUITION INCOME

Code **DFG** Issued **9/12**

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for collection of tuition from nonresident students.

The center will accept nonresident student applications on a space available basis and according to the admission requirements established in policy JFAB Admission of Nonresident Students.

The board will collect tuition from nonresident students who enroll in the center based on a per pupil allocation as follows.

- 25% of the per pupil state allocation for enrollment in one session per day
- 50% of the per pupil state allocation for enrollment in two sessions per day

The center will collect tuition prior to enrollment.
