

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

Code **EEA** Issued **9/18**

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for management of student transportation.

Transportation of students from the feeder high schools in Barnwell County will be provided by regular school buses.

Students may have the privilege to drive their personal vehicle to the career center. Students must follow the driving rules from their home school and adhere to the driving policy at the Barnwell County Career Center. However, all drivers and passengers must have written permission from their parents/legal guardians, the high school, and the center director prior to driving or riding.

Students driving or riding without permission will be referred to the director for disciplinary action.
