

## **ACCOUNTABILITY/COMMITMENT TO ACCOMPLISHMENT**

Purpose: To ensure accountability for the board and for all facets of center operations and programs.

In order to realize its vision and remain accountable, the board will maintain a program of accountability that consists of the following strategies.

The educational philosophy at the Barnwell County Career Center is to provide educational opportunities for those who desire occupational training to qualify for the world of work in business and industry and for service in the community.

The center will perform the following strategies in order to document the success of this mission and of meeting Perkins standards.

- Eighty percent of the students enrolled in occupational programs will demonstrate mastery of at least 85 percent of competencies identified on the state's competency profiles for each occupational course in which they are enrolled.
- Placement for students includes employment, military service and post-secondary education. The percent of occupational completers who are positively placed will equal or exceed 50 percent
- The annual evaluation designed to measure the effectiveness of occupational education programs under the Perkins Act System of Standards and Measures of Performance will be conducted and the results of the evaluation will be on file for review.
