

QUALIFICATIONS OF THE DIRECTOR

Code **CBA** Issued **12/02**

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for the qualifications of the director.

The director will have earned at least a master's degree, preferably a doctorate, in the area of educational administration from a recognized accredited institute. The board also requires all other minimum licensing and certification requirements specifically set forth by the South Carolina State Board of Education.

The director will be the chief executive of the center and, as such, the board will expect him/her to provide leadership in all phases of the educational program.

Persons considered for this position should have at least five years of experience in education with two of these years in administration either in education or the public or private sector. In meeting this requirement, the board may make appropriate allowance for the possession of earned advance degrees.

Because this is an administrative and leadership position at the highest level in the public schools, demonstrated competence in these areas is a necessary prerequisite for this position. Additionally, persons considered for this position should have maintained active membership and participated in the professional organizations concerned with educational administration at local, state and national levels.
