

CODE OF CONDUCT

Code **JICDA** Issued **9/04**

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for a code of conduct and discipline for students.

The center's code of conduct and discipline is established to achieve and maintain order in the center. In administrative rule JICDA-R, the board and the administration offer a list of offenses along with the required or recommended dispositions for the information of students, parents/legal guardians and center personnel.

Disciplinary actions will include appropriate hearings and review. The removal of a student from the learning environment will occur only for just cause and in accordance with due process of law. The administration will consider extenuating circumstances when taking disciplinary action.

The administrative rule is effective during the following times and in the following places.

- on the center grounds during and immediately before or immediately after school hours
- on the center grounds at any other time when the center is being used by a school group
- off the center grounds at a center activity, function or event
- en route to and from the center on a school bus or other school vehicle

 - 1. Section 59-19-90 - General powers and duties of school trustees.
